The coordinate Bench of this court, on 21.06.2021, had passed the following order:-

Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C praying for granting anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0068 dated 08.04.2021, under Sections 307, 341, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Nakodar, District Jalandhar.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that the injury attributed to both the petitioners is simple in nature and that the injury under Section 307 IPC has been attributed to Jasbir Singh. This contention has not been controverted by the learned State counsel.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties, this Court finds it a fit case where concession of interim protection should be given to the petitioners.

In the meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. The petitioners shall join investigation before the Investigating Agency/Officer. They shall abide by the following conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C:-

- (i) That the petitioners shall make themselves available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required to do so.
- (ii) That the petitioners shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the court or to any police officer.
- (iii) That the petitioners shall not leave India without prior permission of the court.”

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Surjit Singh, states that the petitioners have joined the investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioners having joined investigation, the order dated 21.06.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
