Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to terminate the pregnancy of the child in the womb of the petitioner, which is about 25 weeks and 06 days in consonance to the report (P-1), given by respondent No.2.

The co-ordinate Bench while issuing notice of motion on 08.06.2021 passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is carrying more than 25 weeks old pregnancy and the fetus has developed some abnormalities. In this regard, the attention of the Court is invited to medical report (Annexure P-1) by Post-Graduate Institute of Medical Education and Research, Chandigarh advising medical termination of pregnancy.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Ms. Aarti Goyal, Advocate appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1, whereas, Mr. Alankar Narula, Advocate for Mr. Prateek Gupta, Advocate, appears on behalf of respondent No. 2 and pray for time for filing their response.

On their request, adjourned to 15.06.2021.

Let the petitioner appear on 09.06.2021 for her medical examination before the concerned board constituted by respondent No.2.”

Learned Counsel for respondent No.2 has placed on record the report dated 10.06.2021, submitted by the Permanent Medical Board, Post Graduate Institute of Medical Education & Research (PGIMER), Chandigarh.

In view of the report, referred above, learned Counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition at this stage with liberty to file fresh one in case the occasion so arises.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
