This petition has been filed under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., for grant of 'regular bail' to the petitioner in case FIR No. 481 dated 04.08.2020, registered at Police Station Yamuna Nagar City, District Yamuna Nagar, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 148/149/323/324/307/506 of the IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no overt act other than going with his other two co-accused who actually inflicted injuries is attributed to the petitioner who has been in custody for the past 11 months, with no other criminal case registered against him.

Upon query to learned State counsel, he very fairly does not deny that there is no other criminal case registered against the petitioner and at least as per his instructions and as per perusal of the FIR, no overt injuries are actually attributed to the petitioner.

That being so, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be admitted to bail

upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
