By filing this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No. 79 dated 22.5.2021 registered under Sections 365, 342, 323, 506, 34 IPC and Section 66 E of I.T. (Amendment) Act, 2008 Police Station Division No. 1, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for petitioner as also learned counsel for complainant state that compromise has been effected between the parties. In view of compromise between the parties, CRM-M-27270-2021 has also been filed for quashing the FIR.

Notice of motion was issued. Vide order dated 15.6.2021, petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail and directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel states that petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, petition is allowed. Order dated 15.6.2021 granting interim anticipatory bail to petitioner is made absolute. However petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so by Investigating Agency and shall abide by conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
