This criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 6.

Learned counsel has argued that the petitioner was married to respondent No.4 Dinesh who was maltreated by him and his other relatives (respondent Nos.5 to 7), and though a petition for divorce bearing No. HMA-420-2021 has already been filed by the petitioner before the Court of District and Sessions Judge, SAS Nagar, Mohali, but the same is pending adjudication. Learned counsel has invited the attention of the Court to the representation dated 12.05.2021 (Annexure P-3) and reminder dated 24.05.2021 submitted before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur with a request for providing protection to her life and liberty from her husband and other members of in-laws family. He prays for issuing necessary directions.

After hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court

finds that the divorce petition has been filed recently on 25.05.2021 by the petitioner, which is pending. Apart from it, a perusal of the representation (Annexure P-3) reveals that the petitioner has levelled all kinds of allegations against her husband and other relatives but she has neither given any details of the incidents of maltreatment and beatings, nor the said plea is substantiated with any material. Admittedly, she is presently residing with some other person namely, Jeet Ram and in this regard also she has failed to furnish relevant particulars, muchless her nature of relationship. The apprehension of alleged threat is apparently without any basis.

Therefore, this Court is not inclined to exercise the extra ordinary writ jurisdiction.

Dismissed.
