Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR
No.51 dated 2.5.2021, registered at Police Station Longowal, District
Sangrur under Sections 420, 120-B IPC.

On 11.6.2021, the following order was passed :-

“Learned senior counsel for the petitioner contends
that as per allegations sugar worth Rs.74 lacs was sold by
the complainant-Ram Dass Bansal proprietor M/s Bhavya
Organics Sangrur to M/s Goyal Sales corporation,
Ludhiana a proprietor firm belonging to Abhishek Goyal
and the said deal took place in September-October, 2020.
Learned counsel for the petitioners have pointed out that
admittedly Bachittar Singh is known to the complainant
and the only allegation against him is that upon his

recommendation the said transaction took place. Mr. Sourabh Goel, learned counsel for Yogesh submits that his client has been indicted as an accused being brother of Kapil Garg with whom there was a separate transaction.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurjit Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and the investigation is complete.

In view of the same, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 11.6.2021 is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
