1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of the Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India is for initiating proceedings under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 against the respondents for willful and deliberate disobedience of order Annexure P/1 dated 24.02.2021 in CWP No.12692 of 2020.

3. Learned counsel contends that vide order dated 24.02.2021 CWP No.12692 of 2020 was disposed of by directing the respondents to consider the petitioner for promotion against the vacancies which were lying vacant on account of additional sanctioned posts or retirements or for any other reasons, within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order but despite lapse of the stipulated period of time after supply of copy of the order, needful has not been done till date, therefore the instant petition.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that today copy

of order dated 11.06.2021 has been supplied to him accepting the claim of the petitioner, therefore, the petitioner is not interested in prosecuting the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of as such.

5. In view of order dated 11.06.2021 having been passed by the respondent there is sufficient compliance with order dated 24.02.2021 in CWP No.12692 of 2020, therefore, no action is warranted against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.

6. Accordingly, in the light of position as noted above, the present contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any order.
