By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'pre-arrest bail' upon FIR No. 194, having been registered at Police Station Barwala, District Hisar, on 17.04.2021, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 306/36 of the IPC.

Learned State counsel (on instructions), submits that the petitioner has joined investigation pursuant to the order dated 09.06.2021 and presently his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, the petition has actually been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.

However, if the petitioners' custodial interrogation is required at any stage hereinafter, in the context of the FIR in question, he would be given 7 days notice before arrest, duly shown to be served upon them.

Naturally, if the complainant is aggrieved in any manner, of lack of proper investigation, he would be always at liberty to avail of his remedy as per law.
