Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition, the petitioner seek anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.86 dated 12.05.2021 under Section 3 (1) (s) of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, registered at Police Station Kotwali, District Bathinda.

Vide order dated 10.06.2021 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner was granted *ad-interim* anticipatory bail and directed to join the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 10.06.2021 passed by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and recovery has also been effected from him.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Sukhjeet Kaur, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is now not

required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 10.06.2021 granting *ad-interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
