Through this revision petition an interlocutory order dated 20.05.2021 passed by Civil Judge, Junior Division, Rupnagar, has been challenged. Learned trial court has refused to grant police help to the petitioner.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner fairly admits that now the petitioner is not in possession, however, he submits that he has been illegally dispossessed.

Learned counsel representing the respondents contest this position and states that the petitioner continues to be in possession before the date of filing of the suit.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, it is considered appropriate to request the learned trial court to decide the pending suit positively within a period of one year from today. Learned counsel representing the parties undertake that the parties will produce their evidence immediately and as and when the opportunity is afforded, to

enable the court to dispose of the suit.
