JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.89 dated 03.12.2020 under Sections 376 IPC registered at Police Station Sadiq, District Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner herein contends false implication by contending that allegation of rape has been made on the pretext of marriage while contending that the incident complained of is 04 years old. It is submitted that in fact the petitioner herein has subjected himself to DNA profiling and the DNA report as made available even by the State does not reflect any human semen and male DNA. Apart from that, the matter stands compromised between the parties.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2/complainant does not oppose the grant of regular bail to the petitioner.

Learned State counsel on instructions would submit that the petitioner herein has been nominated as an accused under Section 376 IPC and on the asking of the Court, would inform that the matter stands investigated and challan presented.

I have heard counsel for the parties and have also perused case file.

In view of the fact that the matter stands investigated and the complainant, who is a major herself, through her counsel, would submit that the matter has been compromised and she would have no objection in case regular bail is allowed to the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to allow the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner. The petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
