1. This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking regular bail in FIR No. 166, dated 01.10.2019 under Section 22 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Jhunir, District Mansa.

2. As per the allegations one thousand tablets of TREDOL-100 were recovered from the petitioner. The one of the ground for seeking bail is the custody period and the fact that the trial is not proceeding.

3. Learned State counsel on instructions submits that there are total eight prosecution witnesses and all of them are official witnesses. He submits that an earnest endeavour would be made for examining all the prosecution witnesses within three months from the next date fixed before the trial Court.

4. In view of the statement made the present petition is disposed of at this stage.
