Prayer in the petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.07 dated 23.03.2019 under Section 406 and 498-A of the IPC, registered at Police Station NRI City Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there was a marital discord between the petitioner's son and his wife i.e. the complainant and it was precisely for this reason the complainant had planted a false case against the petitioner and others. He further submits that in compliance of the order dated 02.05.2019, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation. She, on instructions from Inspector Gurwinder Kaur, submits that petitioner is not required for further investigation much less the custodial interrogation.

In view of above, petition is allowed and the order dated 02.05.2019 granting interim bail to petitioner, is made absolute. Petitioner shall abide by the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.
