Learned Additional Chief Secretary, Department of Rural Development and Panchayats, Government of Punjab, while exercising the powers of Appellate Authority under Section 20(6) of the Punjab Panchayati Raj Act, 1994, has revoked the suspension of an elected Sarpanch of the village after noting that there is no financial loss to the Gram Panchayat except some delay in deposit of the amount.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no ground to interfere in the writ petition, as prayed for, is made out.

However, if an enquiry is pending against the Sarpanch on the charge in question, a sincere endeavour should be made for conclusion of the same within 6 months.

Disposed of accordingly.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
