The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Through the instant petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.11 dated 02.02.2020 registered under Section 306 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station GRP Patiala, District Patiala.

Status report by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division GRP, Patiala has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State. Same is taken on record. A copy thereof, has been supplied to the counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jammu Ram reiterates that the petitioner has joined investigation and is no longer

required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 15.07.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
