Petitioners-Virender Kumar and 13 others have jointly filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the retrenchment order dated 17.03.2021 (Annexure P-4).

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Kanica Sachdeva, Assistant AG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondent No.1.

Learned State counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.1, brings to the notice of this Court that P-4 is a consequential order to the order dated 23.02.2021/01.03.2021 (Annexure P-3), passed by the

Additional Chief Secretary to the Government of Punjab, Department of Labour, Haryana. From the perusal of the same, it is evident that the order has been passed under Sub-section 9 of Section 25(N) of the Industrial Disputes Act. Learned counsel for respondent No.1, by making reference to Annexure P-4-the impugned order herein, submits that the petitioners have a remedy to approach the authorities under the Industrial Disputes Act.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he be given liberty to approach the Competent Authority under the Industrial Disputes Act.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with the liberty as prayed for.
