1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition under Section 11 and 12 of the Contempt of the Courts Act, 1971 is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for willful and deliberate disobedience of order Annexure P/1 dated 27.04.2021 as well as undertaking of the respondent of the same date in case titled as 'Kanwar Pahul Singh Vs. State of Punjab and Others' in CWP-PIL No.75 of 2021.

3. Learned counsel contends that vide order dated 27.04.2021 CWP-PIL No.75 of 2021 was disposed of in view of the stand of the Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, that representation/letter dated 21.01.2021 filed by the petitioner would be considered and action in respect thereto taken by the respondent-authorities in accordance with law.

4. Learned counsel further states that after the filing of the contempt petition, the respondents have notified Consumer Mediation Cells, therefore, the grievance of the petitioner has been redressed and the

petitioner is not interested in prosecuting the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of as such.

5. In view of the statement of the petitioner as well as notification of the Consumer Mediation Cells by the respondent pursuant to the decision on representation in terms of stand before Hon'ble the Division Bench in CWP-PIL No.75 of 2021, there is sufficient compliance with order dated 27.04.2021 as well as undertaking of the respondent of the same date in case titled as 'Kanwar Pahul Singh Vs. State of Punjab and Others' in CWP-PIL No.75 of 2021 therefore, no action is warranted against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.

6. Accordingly, in the light of position as noted above, the present contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any order.
