2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.101 dated 22.05.2021, registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468 and 471 IPC, 1860, at Police Station Civil Lines, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 10.06.2021, the petitioner joined investigation, fully cooperated with the police, was released on ad interim pre arrest bail and that his custodial interrogation is not required.
