The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.312 dated 15.06.2020, under Sections 302/34 IPC, registered at Police Station City Barnala, District Barnala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is the daughter-in-law of the deceased and has been implicated in the case because of her matrimonial dispute with the complainant who is the son of the deceased. He further states that only two injuries were caused on the person of the deceased which were on the left leg and right foot. No injury is attributed to the petitioner. The petitioner is a lady with two children and is in custody for over a year.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh, contends that two prosecution witnesses have been examined and 20 more prosecution witnesses are yet to be examined.

Heard.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner is in custody for over a year, she is a lady with two children, the COVID-19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on her furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
