Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.709 dated 03.11.2020, under Sections 193, 297, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Hansi, District Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that co-accused Sonu son of Satyanarayan had lodged a DDR with regard to the accidental death of his father to claim insurance, although he had expired due to cancer. The petitioner is alleged to have connived with the co-accused. He also contends that the petitioner is in custody for over 06 months and recovery of ₹5,000/- is alleged to have been effected from him. He also contends that co-accused namely Sahab Singh and Sonu have been granted regular bail by this Court on 18.05.2021 and 26.05.2021 passed in CRM-M-18918-2021 and CRM-M-19675-2021.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from SI Ranbir states that the challan has been filed but no prosecution witnesses have been examined.

He also contends that the petitioner is also involved in other criminal cases.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, contends that after the arrest of the petitioner in the instant case, he has been implicated in other criminal cases.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 06 months, co-accused have been granted bail, Covid 19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
