SUDIP AHLUWALIA, J. (ORAL)

In this petition, the petitioners, who are the accused persons in F.I.R No.61, dated 07.03.2018, under Sections 420, 498-A, 406, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station City South Moga, District Moga (Annexure P-1), have prayed for quashing of F.I.R. with all subsequent proceedings pending therefrom, on the basis of compromise.

2. Now complainant-Respondent No.2 has arrived at a settlement with the accused persons vide Compromise (Annexure P-2), which is duly signed by them. The matter was referred to the Court below for recording of statements of the parties and to report with respect to genuineness of the compromise arrived at between the parties. The Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Moga, vide report dated 20.09.2018 has apprised this Court that the compromise arrived at between the parties is genuine and without any pressure.

3. Respondent No. 2 is represented by her Counsel who does not dispute the factum of compromise.

4. In view of the report of the The Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Moga, and in view of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in “Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another”, 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and “Narinder Singh and Others Vs. State of Punjab and Another”, (2014) 6 SCC 466, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose can be served by keeping with the criminal proceedings pending, since the Respondent No.2 has themselves compromised the dispute with the Petitioners/accused.

5. In the circumstances, the present petition is allowed. F.I.R No.61, dated 07.03.2018, under Sections 420, 498-A, 406, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station City South Moga, District Moga (Annexure P-1), and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed *qua* the present Petitioners.
