Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.0052 dated 15.04.2021 under Sections 452, 323, 148, 149, 506 and 427 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Bathinda, District Bathinda. The petitioners apprehended their arrest at the hands of Police, in the above FIR.

On 11.06.2021, the following order was passed by this Court:

“Learned counsel contends that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the FIR which was lodged after a delay of two days, and the alleged injury suffered by the victim is simple in nature.

Meanwhile, the petitioners shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be admitted to interim bail on their furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/ Investigating Officer. The petitioners shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by HC Kuldeep Singh,

states that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 11.06.2021 is made absolute.
