This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0227 dated 31.05.2021, under Section 21(b) Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (Section 27-A Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 added subsequently), Section 51(b) Disaster Management Act, 2005 (Section 51 Disaster Management Act, 2005 added subsequently) and Section 269 Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station City Tohana, District Fatehabad. The petitioner apprehended his arrest at the hands of Police, in the above FIR.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

This Court while issuing notice of motion to the respondent-State on 11.06.2021 had extended the interim protection to the petitioner.

The said order reads as under:-

*“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the alleged contraband was recovered from the co-accused Rakesh alias Bulli and on his disclosure statement the petitioner has been indicated as an accused.*

*Notice of motion 22.11.2021.*

*Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C ”*

Learned State counsel who is assisted by ASI Balwinder does not dispute this fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 11.06.2021 is made absolute.
