Case has been heard through video conferencing on account of COVID-19 Pandemic.

Petitioners allege that both of them are living-in together against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 7 who are related to petitioner No.1.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that the aforesaid private respondents have threatened to cause harm to both the petitioners and in this regard, representation (Annexure P-4) was given on 8.6.2021 to respondent No.2 but till date no action has been taken by the concerned authority in this regard.

On the other hand, learned State counsel submits that petitioner No.2 is just 17 years of age. It is further submitted that even otherwise, no such representation was ever moved by the petitioners. However, he submits that in case any such representation is moved by the petitioners, then

In view of above, without going into merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to consider representation, if any, moved by the petitioners and to provide appropriate protection to the petitioners if so warranted. However, any observations made in this order will not be construed as an expression of opinion on the relationship between the petitioners.
