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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The petitioner claims to be in possession of land wherein he has sown fodder crop and moong crop.

The grievance of petitioner is that private respondents are interfering in cultivation of crops and are preventing him from harvesting the same.

Petitioner has submitted a detailed representation dated 28.5.2021 (Annexure P-15) addressed to respondent No. 2 (Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur).

On a civil suit instituted by private respondents, the learned trial Court has ordered maintenance of status quo.

The petitioner on earlier occasions also filed similar representations and approached this Court seeking similar directions to official respondents to prevent private respondents from interfering in his possession and preventing them from harvesting the crops. Those petitions were disposed of with a direction to official respondents to look into representations and take such action as may be warranted in law.

This petition is also disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to look into representation dated 28.5.2021 (Annexure P-15) submitted by petitioner and take such action as may be warranted in law.
