Case has been heard through video conferencing on account of
COVID-19 Pandemic.

The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Code of
Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case
FIR No.95 dated 27.8.2018 registered for the offences punishable under
Sections 452, 324, 323, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code (for short, "IPC")
(Section 307 IPC added later on) at Police Station Kulgarhi, District
Ferozepur.

On the last date of hearing, notice of motion was issued to the
State and at the same time, the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory
bail and he was directed to join the investigation with the police.

Today, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Raj
Singh of PS Kulgarhi, Ferozepur, made statement that the petitioner has
joined investigation and got recovered the sword used by him at the time of

the occurrence and he is not required by the police for any further investigation.

As per copy of MLR of injured-Shinda, two injuries were found on his person, which were declared simple in nature by the concerned doctor who conducted his medico-legal examination. The said injuries were found to be caused with blunt weapon.

In view of above, no purpose is going to be served even if the petitioner is sent to police custody at this stage. Consequently, present petition is hereby allowed and order dated 11.6.2021 whereby interim anticipatory bail was granted by this Court to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions as specified in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and he should join further investigation as and when called by the police to do so.
