Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C.
seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.35 dated 22.05.2021, under
Section 61 of Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station Phul,
District Bathinda.

Vide order dated 11.06.2021, this Court while granting
the concession of interim anticipatory bail directed the petitioner to
join investigation.

On instructions, learned State counsel submits that the
petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation
is no longer required.
