During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioners that the representation (Annexure P-5) was sent

to respondent No.2 on 9.6.2021 by registered post and the present petition was also filed on that very day.

At this stage, Mr. Sukhdeep Parmar, DAG, Haryana, on instructions from ASI Diler Singh states that an FIR No.171 dated 8.6.2021, under Section 346, Police Station Pehowa, has already been registered upon a complaint by respondent No.4-Puran Singh (father of petitioner No.1).

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioners, this Court finds that admittedly, the petitioners despatched the representation (Annexure P-5) on 9.6.2021, whereas the present petition has also been filed on the same date. It is evident that before approaching this Court, no time was given to respondent No.2 by petitioners, to consider their grievance, muchless to respond to the same. Even otherwise, it has been brought to the notice of this Court by learned State counsel that an FIR with regard to missing of petitioner No.1 has already been registered, and it shows that the father of petitioner No.1 has adopted a remedy available under the law, so the apprehension of threat expressed by the petitioners is misplaced. Besides, the request (Annexure P-5) is also vague and lacks material particulars regarding alleged manner or mode of threat extended to the petitioners.

Resultantly, no case is made out for exercise of extra ordinary writ jurisdiction.

Dismissed.
