Present contempt petition has been filed alleging non-compliance of order dated 22.01.2020 (P-1) passed by this Court in CWP No. 1670 of 2020. Whereby the writ petition was disposed of with a direction to the respondents to look into the legal notice dated 22.12.2016 (Annexure P-8) and pass appropriate order in accordance with law keeping in view the various decisions relied upon by the petitioner. It was further directed that if no order is passed within a period of four months then respondents will pay costs of Rs. 25,000/- to the petitioner.

A short reply on behalf of the respondents has been filed and wherein it is stated that the costs of Rs. 25,000/- has been paid to the petitioner on 09.02.2021 through Bank Draft (Annexure R-1). It is further stated that the claim of the petitioner has been duly accepted and the petitioner has been granted the pay scale i.e. PB-2, 9300-34800+4800 grade pay notionally from the date of his absorption in

Education Department i.e. 15.04.2009 and actual prospectively.

In view thereof, the present petition is disposed of as having become infructuous.

Needless to add that, it would be open for the petitioner to assail the order, if still aggrieved, in accordance with law.
