The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioners have come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* by directing the respondents to release the arrears of dearness relief/allowances as per their entitlement, granted by the respondents and in view of the judgment dated 25.07.2016 passed in CWP No. 12980 of 2015 alongwith interest @ 9% per annum, for which, “**Notice of Demand of Justice**” dated 05.08.2020 (Annexure P-7) and

reminders dated 10.01.2021 and 26.05.2021 in continuation of “**Notice of Demand of Justice**” (Annexures P-8 and P-9), respectively, have also been served by the petitioners.

Heard.

In the light of oral submissions of the petitioners' side directions are issued to respondents to duly consider the “**Notice of demand of Justice**” dated 05.08.2020 (Annexure P-7) and subsequent reminders (Annexure P-8 and P-9) as representations of the petitioners and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.
