Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No. 60 dated 05.04.2021, registered under Sections 61 and 78 of Punjab Excise Act, 1914 at Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the case file.

No grounds to interfere, particularly in view of the antecedents of the petitioner as disclosed by the learned State counsel, who is appearing on advance service. He submits that per his instructions from ASI Rajinder Singh as many as six other FIRs are registered against the petitioner and he is a habitual offender in committing one or the other crime and, therefore, does not deserve any discretion from this Court.

petition, absolutely to the contrary, stating that no other FIR is pending against the petitioner.

In view such deliberate concealment, he does not deserve any concession on that ground alone.
