Though the Superintendent of Police, Jhajjar, had been directed to file an affidavit as per the last order, an affidavit has been filed by the ASP, Badli, District Jhajjar, dated 26.10.2021, which nevertheless is ordered to be taken on record, as the same answers the query of this court.

It has been stated by the ASP that as per the opinion of the doctor, the tooth of the complainant was also found to be broken and simple injuries etc. also found on his chest and abdomen, with offences punishable under Sections 323, 325, 367 and 397 of the IPC therefore added in the FIR.

There is no other criminal case stated to have been registered against the petitioner as per the instructions of learned State counsel.

That being so, the petitioner having been in custody for almost one

year and the trial still not having effectively commenced, with no prosecution witnesses examined so far, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, subject to her furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial court.
