AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioners have approached this Court praying for issuance of a direction for protection of their lives and liberty, which they apprehend is in jeopardy, from private respondents No. 4 to 6.

Learned counsel for the Union Territory of Chandigarh-respondents No. 1 to 3, on instructions from ASI Rajni Devi, Police Station Sector-36, Chandigarh, states that the private respondents have given a statement that they would not, in any manner, harm the petitioners.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh-respondent No. 2 to ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioners is not jeopardized, in any manner, at the behest of respondents No. 4 to 6 except in accordance with law.
