By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail, upon FIR no.55, dated 10.3.2021, having been registered at Police Station Moti Nagar, Ludhiana, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 307/323/332/353/186/148/149/427 of the IPC.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Mewa Ram, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation pursuant to the order dated 18.6.2021 and presently his custodial interrogation is not required.

He also submits that a cheque for an amount of Rs.1,00,000/- has been furnished by the petitioner to the investigating officer.

In view of above, the petition has actually been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.

However, if the petitioners' custodial interrogation is required at any stage hereinafter, in the context of the FIR in question, he would be given 7 days notice before arrest, duly shown to be served upon them.

Naturally, if the complainant is aggrieved in any manner, of lack of proper investigation, he/she would be always at liberty to avail of his/her remedy as per law.
