Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition while submitting that in case, the petitioner will be having threat perception against the private respondents, she would be moving a fresh representation to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, exclusively praying therein for the protection of her life and liberty and she further prays that the said respondent be directed to take appropriate action on the fresh representation, if so filed, within some specific time frame.

Learned State counsel has no objection to the above-said submission as well as the prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner.

Resultantly, the petition in hand stands dismissed for having been withdrawn with the observations that in case, the petitioner moves any

fresh representation to respondent No.2, restricting her prayer therein to the protection of her life and liberty only, then the said respondent will look into the same and in case the petitioner would be found to be genuinely deserving the protection of her life and liberty, then he will take appropriate action in accordance with law, in the given set of facts and circumstances of the matter, preferably within a period of 10 days thereafter.
