Case heard via video conferencing.

By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'pre-arrest bail', upon FIR No. 126 having been registered at Police Station Hassanpur, District Palwal, on 09.05.2019, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 148/149/307/120-B of the IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Today, learned State counsel, on instructions from the police official who is present in court, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and her custodial interrogation is not presently required.

In view of the above fact, though the status report filed by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Hodal, dated 17.09.2021, is to the effect that the petitioner may influence witnesses if she is admitted to bail, however what is to be noticed by this court is that she had already been admitted to interim bail on 16.06.2021, pursuant to which he joined investigation and in

the other part of the reply it is stated that the report under the provisions of Section 173 (2) of the Cr.P.C. has been submitted to the trial court.

That being so, for the reasons already stated in the order dated 16.06.2021, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, the petition is allowed with the said order made absolute, on the same terms and conditions.
