Case heard by video conference.

By this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.192, dated 06.06.2020, registered at Police Station Sohana, District SAS Nagar, alleging therein the commission of the offences punishable under Sections 452, 323, 324 and 34 of the IPC, as also all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of a compromise (Annexure P-2), arrived at between the petitioners and respondent no.2

Pursuant to the order of this Court dated October 30, 2020, the report of the learned JMIC, SAS Nagar, dated 30.12.2020, is on record, stating therein that statement of the complainant, Sarabjit Kaur (respondent no.2 herein), was recorded before that court, to the effect that the matter has been settled with the accused persons, i.e. the petitioners herein, namely Ravinder Singh alias Ravi, Prince alias Parisdeep Singh, Harry alias Harinder Pal Singh and Jaswinder Singh alias Kala, with their statements also having been recorded before that court to similar effect.

The statement of the investigating officer was also recorded before that court to the effect that none of the accused was absconding or declared to be a proclaimed offender and that there is no other criminal case pending against them.

As per the assessment of that court, the compromise is seen to have been arrived at between the parties without any undue influence and coercion.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent no.2 reaffirms the said respondents' commitment to the compromise

That being so, looking at the nature of the offences alleged to have been committed by the petitioners and the fact that the matter has been amicably settled between the petitioners and the complainant, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.192, dated 06.06.2020, registered at Police Station Sohana, District SAS Nagar, alleging therein the commission of the offences punishable under Sections 452, 323, 324 and 34 of the IPC, along with all proceedings emanating therefrom, is hereby quashed.
