The petitioner herein seeks the relief of anticipatory bail in the criminal case pertaining the FIR bearing No.18 dated 11.04.2021 registered at Police Station City Raikot, District Ludhiana (Rural), under Sections 452, 324, 427 and 34 IPC.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Balbir Chand, Police Station City Raikot, District Ludhiana (Rural), apprises the Court that in compliance of the order dated 16.06.2021 as passed by this Court, the petitioner had joined in the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required and he is also not involved in any other criminal case of the similar nature.

In view of the above-discussed submission of learned State counsel, the instant petition is allowed and the interim relief as granted to the petitioner vide the said order dated 16.06.2021, is hereby made absolute.
