Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 597 dated 24.12.2020, registered under Sections 201, 341, 365, 395, 379-B, 412, 506, 120-B, 34 IPC, (Sections 394, 397 IPC were deleted), at Police Station City Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the FIR was lodged on the complaint of Deva Ram. The petitioner was neither named in the FIR, nor any role was attributed to him and he has falsely been implicated in the present case. The petitioner has been in custody since 13.01.2021.

While opposing the prayer for bail, learned State counsel submits that the recovery of Rs.1,57,000/-, purse, photocopies of Aadhar Card and voter card of the complainant, has been effected from the petitioner, which shows the involvement of the petitioner in the present case. The petitioner is also involved in one another case of a similar nature.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

The allegations levelled against the petitioner are serious in nature. The recovery, as pointed out by the learned State counsel, has been effected from him. Moreover, the petitioner is also stated to be facing the trial in another case of similar nature. There is an apprehension that in case the petitioner is released on bail, he may commit such or similar offence again in future and every effort may be made by him to either tamper with the evidence or win over the witnesses.

In view of the above, I do not find any ground to grant him the concession of regular bail.

Dismissed.
