The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.111 dated 30.04.2021 registered under Sections 323, 379, 448, 506 and 34 IPC at Police Station Khol, District Rewari.

Notice of motion was issued on 17.06.2021 and the parties were relegated to Mediation and Conciliation Centre at District Courts, Rewari in order to explore possibility of any amicable resolution of dispute. As per report of Mediator parties could not settle the dispute before the Mediation Centre.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that basically the dispute is on account of family feud and allegations would be tested with reference to the nature of evidence to be led by the complainant and rebuttal thereof by the accused.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Manoj Kumar admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer and the petitioner is no more required for further investigation of the case. Petitioner is a lady aged 60 years.

In the very nature of allegations and the facts and circumstances of the case, I deem it appropriate to confirm the order dated 17.06.2021. Petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and she shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
