Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in fact the suspension order dated 13.4.2021 (Annexure P-5) by which the petitioner has been suspended is only due to the *mala fide* of respondent No.4, who is all out to ensure that the petitioner does not remain in service. Learned counsel for petitioner further submits that respondent No.4 became biased, after petitioner got an interim order from this Court in respect of the transfer, which was effected by respondent No.4, transferring the petitioner to Haryana Armed Police, Madhuban.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that all the facts and circumstances have already been brought to the notice of the higher authorities including the Director General of Police, while submitting the legal notice dated 03.06.2021 (Annexure P-7) and the petitioner will be satisfied, at

this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Ms. Shubhra Singh, Addl. A.G. Haryana, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and raises no objection with regard to the prayer of the petitioner for deciding legal notice dated 03.06.2021 (Annexure P-7) by respondent No.2 in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 03.06.2021 (Annexure P-7), respondent No.2 is directed to decide the legal notice dated 03.06.2021 (Annexure P-7) by passing a speaking order within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
