1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that in view of the petitioners having been called for interview in terms of order dated 06.02.2020 in CWP No.3190 of 2020, the petitioners do not wish to pursue the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of as such, while learned State Counsel states that in view of compliance of the orders of Hon'ble the Writ Court dated 06.02.2020 in CWP No.3190 of 2020, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is warranted against the respondent.

3. I have considered the submissions of learned counsel for the parties.

4. Admittedly, orders of the Writ Court dated 06.02.2020 in

CWP No.3190 of 2020 have been complied with and the petitioners called for interview for the post of Station Supervisor (SC Category). In the circumstances, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is called for against the respondent.
