By way of this petition, the petitioner has sought the indulgence of this Court for the issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus directing respondents No.1 to 4 to produce and to get the detainee named Neelam Devi @ Tannu, his daughter, released from the illegal custody of respondent No.5.

Vide the order dated 16.6.2021, respondent No.2 had been directed to ensure the presence of the said detainee before the Court of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kurukshetra on 21.6.2021, who was to record her statement.

Today, power of attorney filed by Mr. Priyanshu Kamra, Advocate on behalf of respondent No.5, has been received and the same has been placed on the record.

Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kurukshetra has also sent the statement of the said detainee, as recorded in compliance of the aforesaid order, to this Court wherein the afore-named detainee has categorically stated that she does not want to go to her parents as she is receiving threats from her family members and rather, she wants to stay with respondent No.5 and she had joined his company out of her own sweet will.

In view of the above-discussed contents of the statement of the alleged detainee who has, undisputedly, attained the age of majority, the present petition deserves dismissal.

Resultantly, the same stands dismissed accordingly.
