The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of a direction to respondents to take action in accordance with law on the complaint dated 25.03.2021 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner regarding injuries sustained by her in a vehicular accident.

In pursuance to order dated 05.07.2021, State counsel has instructions, from ASI – Bhag Singh, to state that though the parties had entered into a compromise initially, yet it did not work out.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that before approaching this Court, the petitioner has submitted a complaint dated 25.03.2021 (Annexure P-2) to the police authorities, however, the same has not been attended to. Counsel submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the official respondents to look into the same.

Request made by the counsel for petitioner has been considered.

Without expressing any opinion on the allegations made in the petition or in the complaint, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar (Mohali) - respondent No.2 to examine the complaint dated 25.03.2021 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner and thereafter to take appropriate steps as warranted in accordance with law.

A copy of the complaint dated 25.03.2021 (Annexure P-2) along with the petition be communicated to respondent No.2 so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
