Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Copy of short reply dated 21.08.2021, by way of affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Bapoli, District Panipat, filed in Registry, is taken on record.

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.324 dated 01.06.2021, registered at Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat, under Sections 186, 188, 332 and 353 IPC and Sections 1 and 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 (Haryana Amendment Bill, 2020).

Vide order dated 21.06.2021 passed by this Court, the petitioner had been granted *ad interim* pre-arrest bail and directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 21.06.2021 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation.

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Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Dinesh Kumar, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is now not required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 21.06.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
