The grouse of petitioner Rabinder Kaur is that an application filed by her under Sections 24 and 26 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 in a divorce petition brought by her husband Ravinder Singh against her pending in the Court of Sh. Manoj Kumar, Family Court, Amritsar, has not been disposed of despite passage of a long time.

By way of filing the present revision petition issuance of necessary direction to the trial Court in that regard is being sought.

No doubt on account of breaking out of COVID-19, the functioning of the Courts has been adversely affected since March, 2020 but the application in question is stated to be pending since the year 2018. Such type of application needs to be decided promptly and expeditiously. Accordingly, this petition is disposed of directing the Presiding Officer, Family Court, Amritsar to decide the application in question

The needful be done within one month from today and if it is not done, then the Presiding Officer shall submit explanation to this Court for not doing so.
