This is a petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 11 dated 10.02.2021 under Sections 379-B/34 of the IPC (Section 473/411 added later on) registered at Police Station Banur, District Patiala, Punjab.

As per the allegations in the FIR registered at the instance of one Sarabjit Kaur, it is stated that when she was going to her field, two young persons came on a black colour motorcycle and snatched her gold ear rings and ran away.

Learned State counsel submits that in the Test Identification Parade, the complainant has identified the petitioner as one of the offender.

Learned State counsel further submits that the petitioner is involved in 02 more FIRs of similar nature, wherein, two victims namely Kuldip Kaur and Jogindero have also identified the petitioner in the Test Identification Parade and, therefore, the petitioner is a habitual offender.

Learned State counsel further submits that in FIR No.228 of 2014, the petitioner already stands convicted for a period of 05 years in offence under Section 307 of the IPC.

In view of the same, learned counsel for the petitioner, seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.
