Petitioners-Dev Singh along with ten others, have jointly filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer to issue a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to implement the orders dated 28.12.2016 (Annexure P-7).

Records of the case show that vide order dated 07.07.2021, this Court had issued notice of motion.

Today, on the resumed hearing of the case, learned counsel for respondents No.3 & 4 submits that the present writ petition has become infructuous as the substantial relief has already been granted to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the State also submits that he has instructions from the department to submit that prayer of the petitioner to implement the orders dated 28.12.2016, has been rendered infructuous as the substantial relief has been granted to the petitioners.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of as having become infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is at liberty to move an appropriate application, in case, after lapse of two months, the necessary substantial relief is still not granted to them.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he be given liberty to move a representation for any or such of the reliefs that the respondents have not granted to the petitioners.

It is directed that in case, such representation is filed, the same be decided within a period of one month from the date of filing of the representation.

Ordered accordingly.
