Present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 3(1)(b) of Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988 for direction to the respondents to temporarily release the petitioner on emergency parole to perform last rites of his mother who died on 10.06.2021.

Although, learned State counsel, on instructions from Assistant Sub Inspector Dilbag Singh, has opposed the prayer on the premise that petitioner is having two real brothers to do the needful; but concededly, his mother has expired, therefore, in the opinion of this Court, petitioner deserves emergency parole.

Consequently, this petition is allowed; petitioner is ordered to be released on emergency parole for a period of 10 days with immediate effect subject to the terms and conditions to be imposed by the competent authority. He shall surrender back before the jail authorities on 28.06.2021 at 10:00 A.M.
