Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.55 dated 28.06.2020 registered under Sections 323,324,148,149 IPC, 1860 (Section 326 IPC, 1860 added later on) at Police Station Mehna, District Moga.

Initially the FIR was registered under Sections 323,324,148,149 IPC. Offence under Section 326 IPC was added vide GD No.14 dated 02.07.2020.

As per allegations, the petitioner Harmeet Kaur inflicted injury with a sharp edged weapon on left shoulder of the

complainant. Accused-Jaspreet Singh also inflicted injury on the left hand of the complainant with sharp edged weapon. Complainant received three injuries in total. Injury No.1 is found to be grievous injury, attracting offence under Section 326 IPC.

Vide order dated 28.07.2020 interim directions were issued and the petitioner was directed to join the investigation. During pendency of the present petition, even challan has been presented before the Court.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sukhman Singh submitted that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required. However learned State counsel opposed the bail on the ground that petitioner is involved in giving threats even after filing of challan and the complainant has not been allowed to enter upon the land.

Since the challan has already been presented, therefore, this petition is disposed of by making the order dated 28.07.2020 absolute.
